SPPA MENTORSHIP CIRCLES – CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

Dear alumni and students,

We are pleased to announce the launch of a new round of mentorship circles at SPPA.

Circles have 3 members (3 of the 4 categories represented in each circle):

- **Level 1:** 1 Upper year BPA/MPPAL student or recent graduate at entry level position
- **Level 2:** 1 Analyst/Advisor
- **Level 3:** 1 Manager
- **Level 4:** 1 Sr. Executive E.g.: Director, ADM, DM

Each group will consist of a Level 1, 2 and 3 or a Level 2, 3 and 4.

The minimum commitment is to hold two meetings for each mentorship circle by the end of March 2018, and the third (final) meeting by the end of May 2018 the latest, with the aim to advance the professional development and careers of participating members.
